Peter Greenbaum (who was calling himself Peter Green by age fifteen) played bass in several amateur bands before being invited to play lead in the band, Peter B's Looners, in early 1966. It was here that the nineteen-year-old guitarist first encountered Mick Fleetwood, the group's drummer. He stayed for three months before leaving to join John Mayall's Bluesbreakers. He had been an avid fan of the Bluesbreakers' guitarist, Eric Clapton, but when Clapton left the group for good, Peter was hired as his replacement. It was in the Bluesbreakers that Green solidified his relationship with the rhythm section, John McVie, and Mick Fleetwood. When he left the group in 1967, Green would recruit the two in order to found his own

W.	band, Fleetwood Mac. His song 'Black Magic Woman' became a massive hit for Carlos Santana. Peter was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame on January 12, 1998 where he played Black Magic Woman with his fellow inductee Carlos Santana
